had scam attempt online or by phone, text, email or mail 31%












# Most Michiganders age 50+ say they have enough close friends, but those reporting fair or poor health are less likely to say so

### Making friends is harder for many Michiganders age 50+ now compared to when they were younger, especially for those reporting fair or poor health


Compared to when you were younger, is making friends now harder, about the same, or easier?






